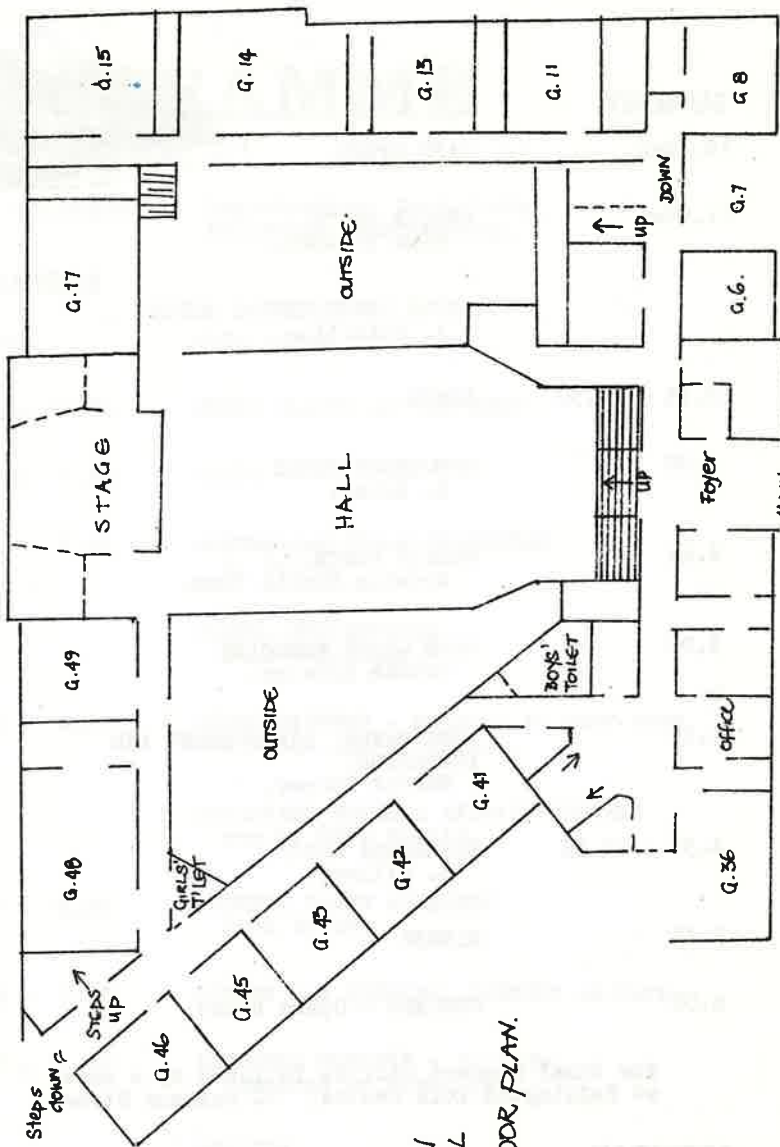

BRENT BLANN'S GUITAR SHOP
