Now living on the East Coast comes the guardian of your political and social conscience Hike Rashbrooke with his own very special blend of pathos and humour in song. and from Kaponga come Janet and Alan Huggeridge, a couple who have made music in Taranaki and had their songs sung and recorded by many.

Under negotiation at the moment is the South American group Canto Conmigo from Palmerston North - we hope to have them here for Saturday afternoon.
