<u>Senior</u> 17 – 25

The best performance will be awarded \$500 2nd place \$250

<u>Junior</u> 11 - 16 Best performance wins \$200, All performers may be considered for a \$50 encouragement award.



Applicants must fill out an **entry form** to be considered for the award The performance **must not** exceed **5 minutes**. This time does not include set up, but does include the introduction

Entrants should briefly introduce their performance, explaining the reason they chose this piece to perform, and its history

Entrants may either be soloists or a group

A group will be assessed by the same performance criteria as a solo performer

A solo entrant may be accompanied by other musicians (of any age), however, **only** the applicant **on the entry form** will be assessed

A performance may be any combination of tunes and/or songs, so long as they fit the musical criteria set out above
